## Wellstar Paulding PFFA Art Show and Sale

We have a wonderful opportunity to promote our Artists, Gallery and Association!

On **November 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014**, we will be holding our first **Art Across Paulding© Show and Sale** at the Wellstar Paulding Hospital on the corner of Bill Carruth and Highway 278! It will be held in the Atrium Lobby at the entrance on the Bill Carruth side. We will be open from about 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM each day.

The hospital has told us that we can hold this as often as once per month! I'm not sure that we can support doing this so often, but perhaps once per quarter would work well. We will assess this after the first event.

Paulette Cheek and Leslie Grant have some display racks that we will set up as display walls for the art so we will have room to hang a LOT of art! In addition we will have several tables set up for smaller items. We will need volunteers to help show visitors around and to collect payment for sales. The hospital will supply a volunteer to help and they will also be able to process sales by payroll deduction for the hospital employees and doctors. All they will need for a purchase is their ID Badge.

We will need artwork in ALL price ranges! So we will be looking for everything from original pieces to prints. Framed, unframed, whatever. Also, the items in the gift shop like handmade jewelry, embroidery, books, etc, can be offered. Please be thinking about what you can offer for sale.
